Eligibility Criteria and Nomination Form

The Emerging Leader Award is given to an early career professional who is a member of ACPA for at least 3 and not more than 15 years, who exhibits exemplary accomplishment and dedication to the issues affecting people with cleft and craniofacial conditions.

After nomination by a member of the Association and review of his or her qualifications by the Honors and Awards Selection Panel, a candidate may be granted the Emerging Leader Award by a two-thirds majority approval of the Board of Directors.

The letter should provide details of the candidate’s accomplishments and contributions that are deemed worthy of the ACPA Emerging Leader Award as identified by the five criteria listed on this nomination form.
